Dear Phoenix Parents/Carers,

This half term Phoenix will be learning about the SRE (Sex and Relationship Education) aspect of their PSHE curriculum. At this stage we will be specifically looking at emotional changes during puberty, how we can be sensitive to others and human reproduction.

Pupils will learn:

- about human reproduction in the context of the human lifecycle
- how a baby is made and grows (conception and pregnancy)
- about roles and responsibilities of carers and parents
- about different relationships and respecting people we care about
- about how the body changes as we go through puberty including discussing emotions and relationships.
- to ask questions about sex and relationships with confidence, where to find support and advice when they need it.

It is an essential part of the curriculum (which is linked closely to our science curriculum) and although it is voluntary we would strongly recommend your child takes part. Please do not hesitate to pop into school to look at the resources we use and the content in the unit of work. I would be happy to talk it through and explain what they will be learning about.
